iPads WILL be required from Year 1.


We appreciate some parents have had reservations about children in FS being responsible for and using an iPad as part of their curriculum. Mr Hallum is listening to your feedback and has made the decision that iPads will not be required until Year 1.

All other students will need to have a device.

For the best performance of school-based application there is a minimum specification.

We all recommend for students in year 7 and 8 to incorporate a keyboard and stylus.

CUBBIES LOCKERS

Each student will be allocated their own space to store their belongings whilst in school.

FS1-Yr 2 will have pegs Year 3 to Year 6 will be allocated a cubby Years 7- Year 8 will be allocated a locker.

This space will enable each student to have a safe space to keep their belongings. You may want to have a spare set of clothes at school for FS children, the cubby can be the place to keep them.

For the older students they may want somewhere to leave their bags when they go for lunch or head outside on their break.

For your convenience we are sharing the dimension to ensure that belongings can fit in the space allocated.

RTA are working very hard and are doing their utmost to have the road ready for when we open.


We politely ask for your patience with them and us and we work to make your experience as easy as possible.
